



Once you have logged into your new account you will need to register your new unit.




- Click the arrow next to the user ID this will open a drop-down menu
- Select *Add instrument* from the menu



Now select either the iVIBE or iDB instrument name from the drop-down menu and enter the 5character ID which can be found in the instrument's paper work and on the label on its enclosure. The ID consists of a letter followed by 4 more numbers or letters. For iDB, it will begin with the letter E, for iVIBE with the letter V (as shown below):

- Enter the country and city as these are mandatory fields and enter the IP address which can also be found in the paperwork and on a label inside the door of the Power Portal.
- The port number should be set to 10002.
- Click *Add instrument* button.

Click the menu button and click *Start/Stop Sampling*, then select the serial number of the instrument that you want to start.




- Click the Enable Auto Clear memory check box (recommended)
